

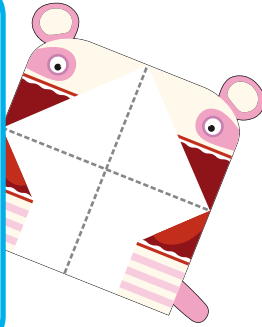
Create some cute Bill and Betti “snap dragons”!

What you need:

- a color printer
- template “Worry Eater fortune teller”
- scissors
- glue

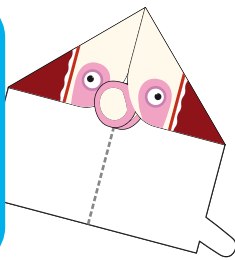

After printing out the template, cut out the shape of Bill and Betti. The template now looks a bit like a square with two ears and two arms. Fold the paper lengthwise and horizontally, creasing the lines. Then, unfold the paper back to the square.



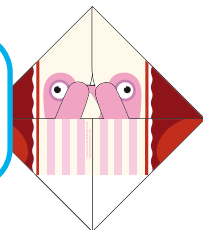

Turn the template over and fold the corners in towards the center, starting with the “ear-parts”, then the “arm-parts”.



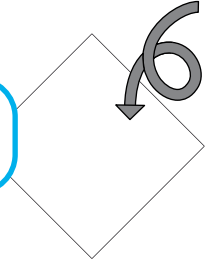

Now, you should have a smaller square shape.



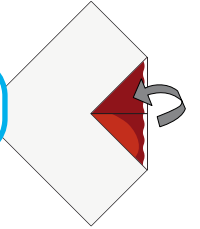

Again, turn the square over.



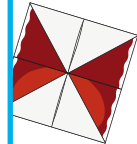

Now, fold the corners in again.



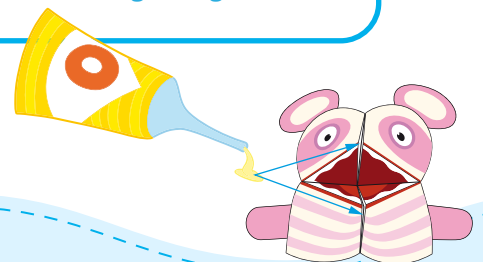

You are now left with an even smaller square – two of the triangles being white, two triangles showing the inner part of the mouth!

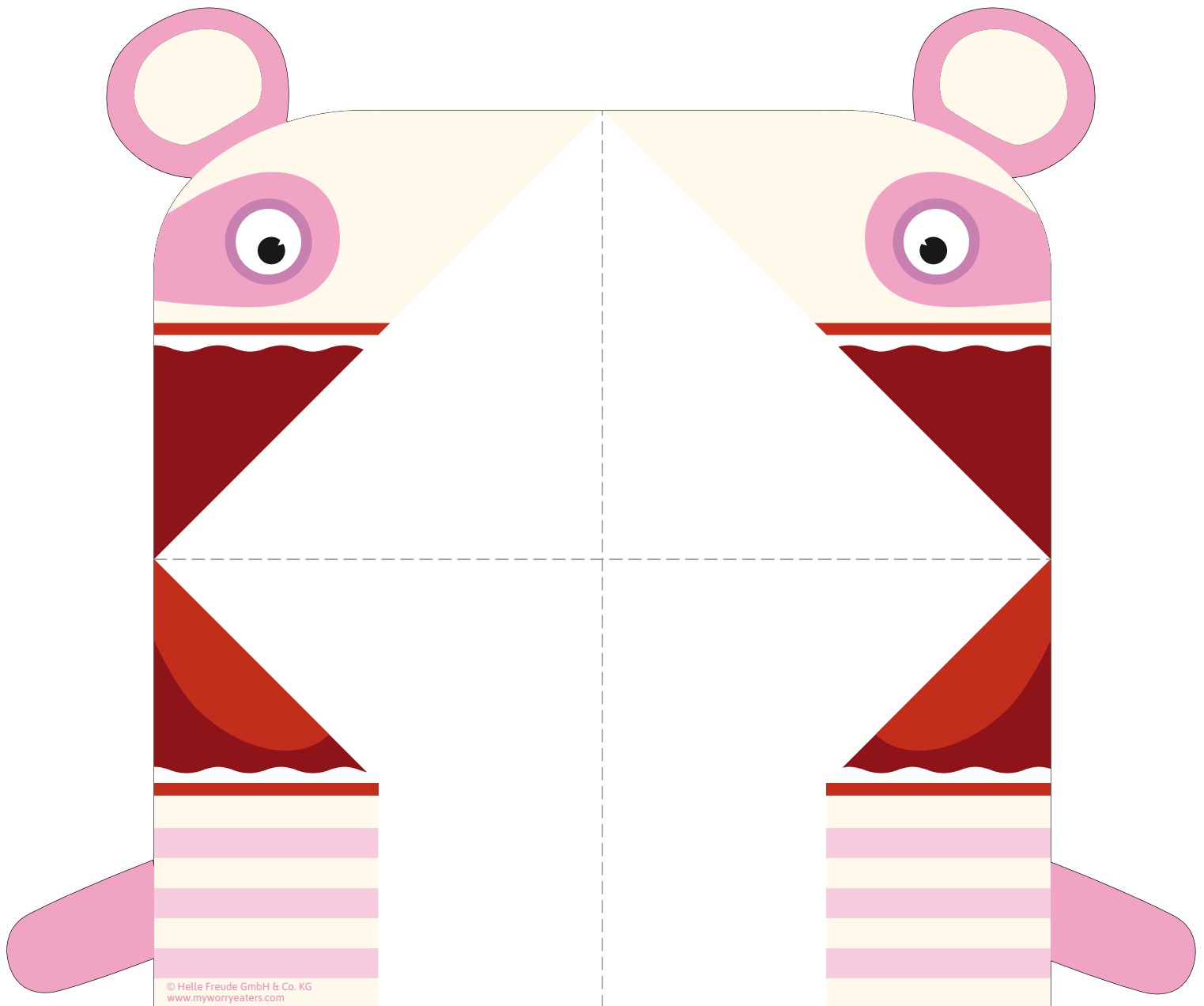


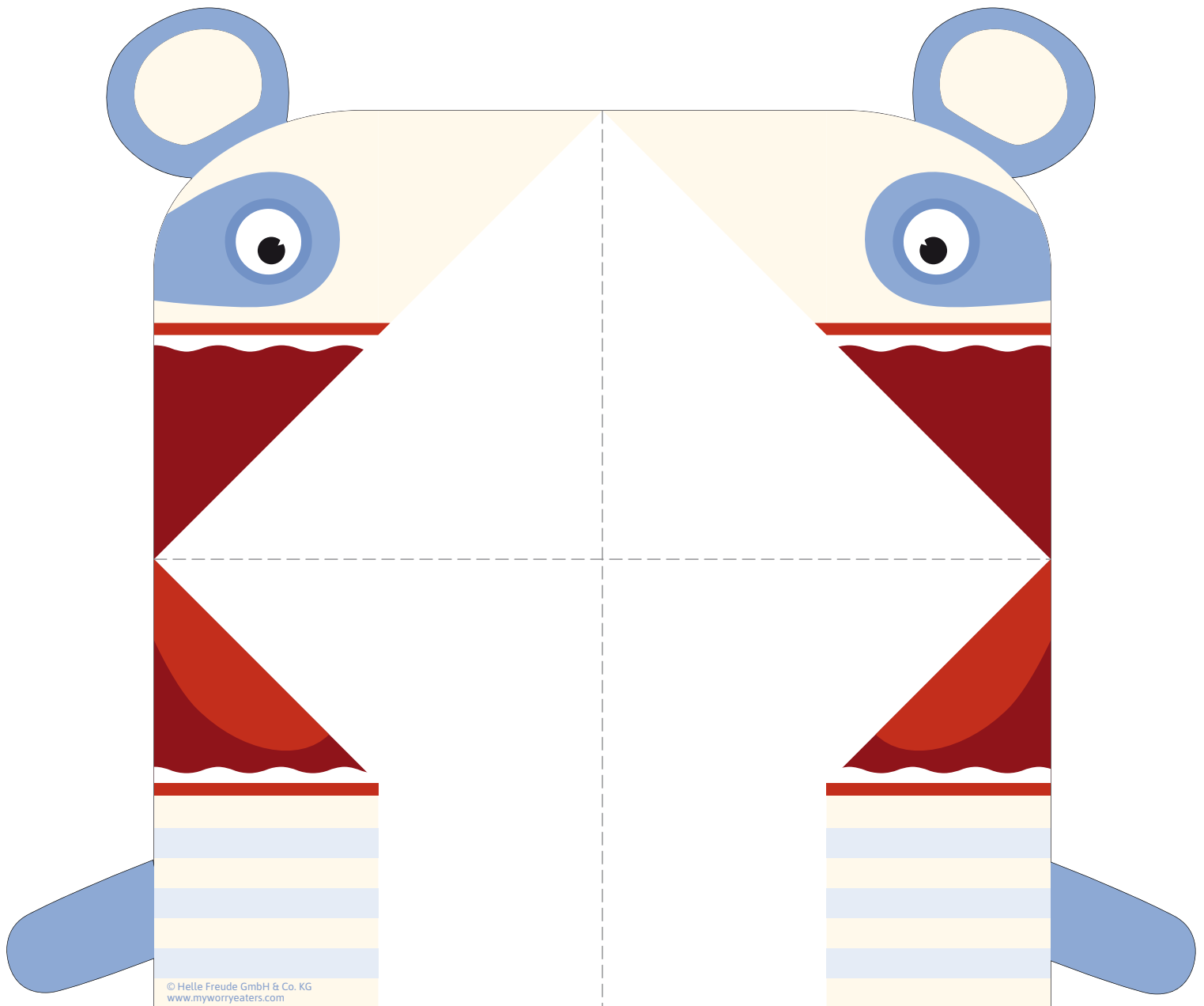

Turn the paper back over to find the ears and arms again. Carefully pull them outwards: Now, the center should slightly move inwards. Put your fingers into the empty spaces below and – TADA! Bill and Betti are smiling at you! To fixate the face, glue the opposing white triangles together.



*Note: Please always make sure there is an adult around when you are using scissors and go for children’s scissors, because they are much easier and safer to handle! If you are working with glue, please make sure that the room has adequate ventilation and don’t forget to wash your hands when you are finished!
